PRESENTATION - Analytical Hypnotherapy

Hypnosis Can Be Divided Into Two Major Therapeutic Approaches

Directive Hypnosis:

1. Consists of the use of post hypnotic, inferred and positive affirmations describing an event as if it has already taken place. The subconscious mind with its ability to determine reality from fantasy causes neural impulses to travel to the Autonomic Nervous System to bring about an event, which had been "blueprinted" by the image of a suggestion.

2. Non-Directive or Regressive Hypnotherapy (AKA Analytical Hypnotherapy)

The therapist guides clients back to sensitizing and critical events through age regression, but does not lead in anyway. Process work is then used to bring the client to more healthy avenues for expression of behavior.

Barney's presentation will be on the Non-Directive/Regressive approach of Analytical Hypnotherapy.

It involves working with three ego states that exists within all of us, the child, parent and adult ego within us. And of course the therapists contribute the adult state within themselves.

Throughout the analytical procedure, the fundamental assumption maintains that the Adult ego state can find a solution underlying the Parent/Child conflict provided it is given sufficient information. The hypnotherapist must skillfully use these techniques to pry such information from the unconscious memories and allow the adult mind to consider to keep only the learning experience and to let go of the conflicting emotion.

There are 6 steps in the analytical hypnotherapy process that must be followed.

- 1. Identification of the Critical Experience.
- 2. Understanding the Repressed Emotions and the Associated feeling of Guilt.
- 3. Recognition of the Current Irrelevance of the Previously Repressed Emotion.
- 4. Relinquishing the Repressed and Repressing Emotions
- 5. Recognition of the Resolution of the Child/Parent Conflict.
- 6. Rehabilitation.

These will be discussed.

BIO – Barney F. Howell, CHt.

I began my study of hypnosis in the mid-1970s while enlisted in the Air Force. Primarily my interest was to improve my performance in steel tipped dart competition. IT WORKED!

I then found hypnosis was a wonderful skill to use in many other ways for myself and others.

Prior to retiring from service, I found a clinical psychologist, here in Phoenix. She helped me improve my use of hypnosis and it was through her that I was introduced to Ericksonian hypnosis. She had been one of his students.

My professional use of hypnosis (meaning I was actually paid real money) began in 1983 after I retired from the military. People I worked with in the defense industry learned how I was helping with weight control and smoking cessation asked me to work with them on various issues. I learned a lot by reading and practicing the techniques the psychologist had taught me.

In 1998 I decided I needed some documentation that said I actually had a clue what I was doing in hypnosis. I found the Atwood Institute. I took the certification course with them and though I had a good foundation in hypnosis, I learned two areas I had not used or really known about. They were, Past Life Regression Therapy and Analytical Hypnosis.

After completing training with the Atwoods, I assisted Dr. Norman Charrette in his clinic. Through Dr. Charrette and Dr. Patrick Porter I learned and became an NLP practitioner.

In 1999, the Atwoods offered me the school they created in 1989. I accepted and bought the school in 2000. I had the school until the end of 2015 when I closed it and formally retired. It was great teaching and practicing therapeutic hypnosis (which I still provide on a referral basis.)


