# PRESENTATION - James Giunta - 1-Hour Workshop Presentation:

Every client has resistance, and some clients have difficulty going into the hypnotic state and accepting suggestions at the subconscious level. In this workshop, engage with some powerful concepts and techniques that will take even the most resistant clients into a suggestible state in order to bring about relief and success with their issue. Take this workshop and then go about your sessions with more confidence in your abilities and more confidence in your client's ability to trust you.

This workshop teaches that your success in this area is a simple matter of mastering the concepts of rapport, choosing an approach, and then combining several familiar, powerful techniques.

If you are a serious professional, mastery of this subject is essential. If you haven't worked with a highly resistant client up until now, they're just about to call and make an appointment. You're going to need these exercises before they arrive!

Basic Concepts for Dealing with Resistant Clients ~ Must Have: v How we can define "Failure" and "Success" Ø "Don't take the credit, don't take the blame." v Interview Ø Rapport Ø Questions to gain understanding and uncover goals and assess resistance Ø Observe carefully—congruence and incongruence. Ø Which fears are they dealing with? Ø How are they feeling right now, today? What's so? Information is not the same thing as Knowledge. v Approach Ø Determine suggestibility Ø Induction Ø Create hypnotic suggestions based on Personal Style, Learning Style Ø Observe, get feedback, re-assess, continue v Techniques Ø Hypnosis has nothing to do with relaxation. Ø Overloading, confusion, misdirection, compounding Ø Fractionation, Deepening Ø Ego strengthening Ø Provide anchors, stack anchors.

Ø Combine techniques.

Ø How to know when they're working

Ø Your fall-back position

It's OK to get feedback during the session—in fact, don't wait. Allow the client to guide us with comments and important information.

Is depth necessary, and must we hypnotize?

What happens when WE let go of that?

**PRACTICE SESSION:** 

Use techniques in succession and in combination

Write hypnotic suggestions based on Interview, Observation, and Feedback
