A Message from ASPH President

Many years ago, I taught private music lessons. Flute, saxophone, and clarinet. Sometimes it was my job to teach small classes of students learning to play those instruments.

One of the biggest challenges I faced with the class was teaching youngsters of different abilities and experience levels. I was always trying to make sure that the more advanced students weren't bored and could learn and progress so that they weren't wasting their time. And I also had to make sure that the less experienced students got the basic instruction they needed.

It was a delicate balance and made the job a difficult one.

So it was with considerable joy that I sat at the ASPH meeting in January and saw hypnotists and hypnotherapists of different experience levels, different training, different skills, different interests, and different problems. The joy came from knowing that all of these differences contributed to the strength of this group, and that they were responsible for making my job easier, not harder.

Those who needed some advice, guidance, or support were able to get it from those who had more experience. Those who had experience were able to share and learn from those who had different approaches and viewpoints.

So, it seemed that all of us were able to learn, and all of us were able to share. There wasn't just one demonstration; there were three. That gave all of us a chance to participate in meaningful ways.

I remember ASPH meetings in the past where one person would demonstrate, and one person would be the "subject." The rest of us would be spectators. Of course, we could ask questions, and those meetings were very valuable.

Our January meeting - I believe - was valuable in a different way. There was simply more opportunity to participate. So, if you'd like to participate, to experience as much as watch, and to help others while they are helping you, this may be the meeting for you.

Come with questions, with answers you've found, with problems and passions. There is a place for you here.

And besides, there are some very interesting and even cool people at the meetings. You may make a friend or two (or fifteen), learn something you can use immediately, have a unique experience, and maybe even enjoy a few laughs.
